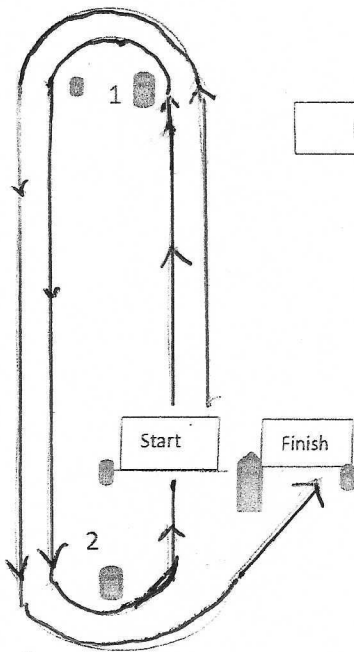


Courses shown below are E2 & W3. The number denotes the number of times the windward mark is passed E.G. a "E1" course when posted will be, Start - 1(P), F line closed, - 2(P) -Finish. ** Finish line closed on downwind (from MK 1 to 2) leg.

A W3 course will be Start - 1(P), - 2(P) -1(P) -2(P) Finish

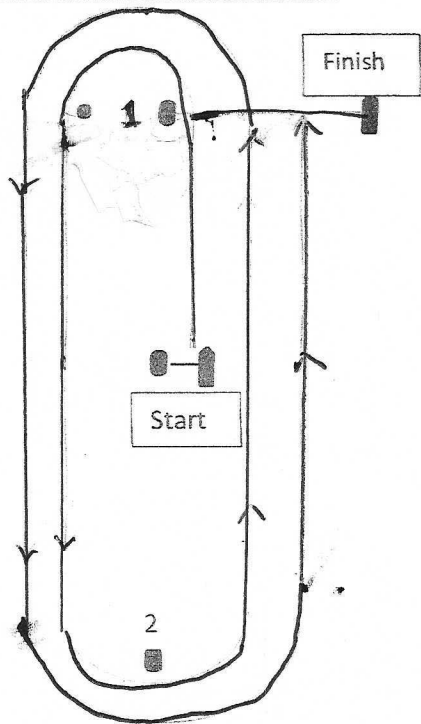
New FOR 2021 - TRIANGLE course - TE2 - as per E2 with additional gybe mark (pass to port) - lap 1 only

Notes Course E2

Mk 1 includes offset if present.

Course:- Start - 1(P), F line closed, -2(P)- 1(P)- F line closed, 2(P)- FINISH

NB finish line closed on downwind leg

Downwind leg is defined as mark 1 to mark 2

Notes Course W3

Mk 1 includes OFFSET if present.

Course:- Start-1(P), -2 (P) -1(P) -2(P) - FINISH

NB Shorten Course

Should an E2 (or TE2) course be shortened to a E1 (or TE1) course, multiple sound signals will be made as the leading boat is rounding mark 2. Flag K will be displayed on the signal boat positioned at the port end of the finish line.
