

LESC Regatta Membership Application

Regatta Season: the LESc regatta season runs from the MC Scow SER Championship [Triple Crown 1] in mid-November through the MCSA Midwinter Championship Regatta [Triple Crown 3] in early March (approximately four months).

Regatta Membership: the goal of the regatta membership program is to promote racing and community for LESc members and MC Scow racers from all over the USA. It is open to sailors whose intention is to participate in LESc regattas through the regatta season. Regatta members are encouraged to join club races in between regattas.

Participants cannot reside in Florida full-time or on a seasonal basis. The program is only available to persons whom the Board of Directors feels meets the spirit of the program and to whom the Board grants permission.

Regatta Membership Duration: Regatta membership runs from Halloween until one week after the MCSA Midwinter Championship Regatta. Regatta members wishing to store boats outside this period will need to apply to the LESc Club Secretary David Leather. At dbjleather@gmail.com

Boat Storage: boat storage is available on either side of the Clubhouse. Storage (north or south side) will be assigned on a first come first served basis.

All regatta boats must be anchored to the ground with Ground Anchors. It is recommended that you strap your boat to the trailer and the trailer to the Ground Anchors. All boats not anchored after a regatta will be anchored for you at a cost.

All regatta boats must have the owner's name and boat storage slot # on the trailer and the slot # on the lower mast facing forward with another slot # on the trailer facing the driver of the tow vehicle. Please use the stick-on 3" letters and numbers available in the Clubhouse.

Regatta Membership Dues: dues are payable prior to entering any regatta or club race. Regatta entry ,as per applicable NOR , is required.

Application for Membership: applicants for membership should complete the attached application form indicating the type of storage requested [mast up or mast down] and, if applicable, the number of weeks outside the regatta membership period that storage is requested and email it to the Club Secretary, David Leather, at dbjleather@gmail.com

The Club will invoice the applicant for the appropriate fees. On receipt of payment membership will commence and applicants will receive a letter confirming the approved storage period. All applications will be reviewed by the Board of Directors for continued membership after 90 days.

By storing your boat on Club property, you agree that, upon expiration of the period for which you have paid storage charges, you will promptly remove from the Club's property your boat and, if applicable, your trailer, dolly or other property or equipment (collectively, your "Boat and Equipment"). You agree that if you fail to promptly remove your Boat and Equipment from the Club's property upon expiry of that period, and your failure continues for more than thirty days after the club sends you a letter requiring you to remove your Boat and Equipment, your Boat and Equipment will be deemed abandoned. You agree that such a letter from the Club will be sent via First Class US Mail addressed to your address as shown in the Club's records, with the thirty days measured from the date the letter is deposited with the US Postal Service. If your Boat and Equipment are deemed abandoned, your Boat and Equipment may be retained by the Club as the Club's own property, sold by the Club, or otherwise disposed of by the Club in any manner the Club finds to be appropriate. In no event shall the Club have any duty to secure, maintain, preserve or protect any Boat and Equipment which is deemed abandoned. Should the Club elect to sell a Boat and Equipment deemed abandoned, the Club may do so for any price acceptable to the Club in its sole and absolute discretion, which need not be fair market value, and the Club may receive and retain the proceeds of the sale and apply those proceeds against the Club's charges for the storage of the abandoned Boat and Equipment and any costs arising from the abandonment of the Boat and Equipment and the Club may retain any balance to be used for the purposes of the club. **By entering my name or signature below and selecting 'Acknowledged', I acknowledge the above and agree to abide by LESCF rules and policies.**
